# TTCA Tournament is quickly approaching—important times/dates

All tournament entry forms must be turned in to your instructor on Monday, March 17<sup>th</sup>. Spectator tickets may also be purchased at a discount, but must be purchased at this time. Hotel reservations (Galt house) should already be made, but if not, please do so ASAP. You must mention TTCA or Traditional TKD to get the discounted rate of 65.00.

## <u>Itinerary for tournament:</u>

- *Friday evening*. Black belt testing at Main school, 7:00 pm. Katie Roe and Kathy Husmann will be testing from DePauw. Come cheer them on.
- Saturday: Be in uniform and downstairs at the tournament by 9:30-9:45. Starts at 10:00 am.

  Be sure to get your hand stamped if you are not going to be competing or doing the demo that evening. Finals begins at 6:00 pm that evening, though you should be there by 5:30 to get a seat. If you are not in the demo, you do not have to be in uniform for the finals unless you are actually competing in a finals match (most children's divisions finish during the day, so this doesn't apply to many).

\*\*Demo team will have the final walk through from 4:30-5:30 in the actual stage area. Be sure to grab a bite to eat after your competition and be back in time for the final practice, where adjustments may need to be made.

- *Saturday after the tournament*: There will be a dance after the finals, from approximately 9-11:00. We had a great time last year at it and hope to see more of you there this year.
- Sunday morning: Check out. We might try to organize a group breakfast that morning.

\*\*\* Be sure to wear you **GMA team shirts** at the finals and throughout the weekend. Demo team will wear their shirts on Saturday, but not during the actual demo. DPU members should wear their warm ups. Team members without warm-ups should see Mr. Sieg.
