FALL FOLIAGE PARADE

Once again, we are proud to be marching in the fall foliage parade, as you will be able to tell by the marching practice we will be doing. Here are some pertinent details. Students will meet at the high school/middle school at 12:15. We are very early in the parade (division 1) so we may be lining up by the middle school instead of the high school. Students will be picked up at the same place. Students will not be allowed to leave on their own and walk back unless this is explicitly discussed with an instructor beforehand and is a reasonable distance, etc. Parents should take into consideration the parade route and congestion in traffic when planning on picking up their children. Keep in mind the parade is long and we are typically done while the parade is still passing some people. Do not necessarily wait until the parade is finished to pick up your child.
